Revisions to Diversity Committee

Discussion: Vince announced that PAC has approved the proposed revisions to the Diversity Committee with minor changes. This opened a discussion with Ken Robinson who impressed upon the committee his desire to be a permanent resource member and given a standing item on the agenda. He expressed his desire to be a district resource to the campus diversity committees to help address local needs and interests, as well as foster greater communications between the campus diversity committees and the district diversity committee advisory. Ken discussed his efforts at the District to create a district diversity advisory committee that would include representatives from the diversity committees of Cypress College, Fullerton College, and the school of Continuing Education, Latino Faculty and Staff Association, Black Faculty and Staff Association, Gay and Lesbian Association of District Employees, students, and the community. He announced that he will be working with these groups to get input as he begins to formulate the mission, vision, goals, and objectives of the new committee and to provide input as the District works to implement the State Chancellors EEO Plan. The committee members agreed that there needs to be more discussion on this matter and how it will impact the mission of the committee. This should be addressed immediately in the coming year.
